Animals All Around Us



You are on a mission to locate an animal that is on the endangered list. Research to select an animal, locate and describe its habitat, and then write a letter to the local wildlife conservation society convincing them to help you save this animal.	Create a composite animal with elements of several animals. Describe the different animals you've combined and why you chose them. Name you're animal.	Plan and present a multimedia presentation about the advantages of preserving specific habitats for the use of the animals and plants living there. Persuade developers to find another location for their mega-mall.
Your parents have given you a choice of adopting a puma or a kangaroo for a pet. Create a Venn diagram comparing and contrasting the two to help you make your choice. Write an article for the local newspaper explaining why you made your choice.	Student Choice	You've just returned from an archaeological expedition to Africa where you discovered the remains of a now extinct animal. Share information about how the animal lived, why it became extinct, and how it might have been saved from extinction. Draw a picture of the way you're animal looked when it was alive.
Research Steve Irwin or any other wild animal advocate. Make a picture book about his life and why his work was so important to both humans and animals.	Write a story from the point of view of an animal who has been forced to share its natural habitat with humans.	Locate several poems and/or songs about animals. Make a list of all of the animals that interest you. Gather facts about five or more of your chosen animals and create poems incorporating those facts.
