

Introductory Coaching Program

The coaching program is an entry-level introduction to working with educators in the role of an instructional coach. Throughout this 10-week course, participants will learn about coaching, create/implement a coaching plan, and develop valuable skills through facilitated interaction with peers in a blended learning format.

(This program is currently only available to educators at non-profit, private schools that qualify for Title II, Part A funds)

Course Objectives

- Understand coaching models
- Use planning tools to prepare high quality instruction
- Engage in a coaching plan
 - Apply problem solving and professionalism as a coach
- Complete all assessments, activities, and sessions for 3 synchronous professional learning sessions and 1 asynchronous introductory coaching course

Requirements

- Applicants will need supervisor approval (e.g., principal, director)
- Applicants must have a minimum of 3 years teaching experience
- Applicants must have a <u>Coaching</u> <u>Program Approval Form</u> completed (due by October 20)
- There will be an initial cap of enrollments at 2 per site (30 total participants)
 - Can be increased if enrollment is low
